**Following Through With Our Lenten Intentions**



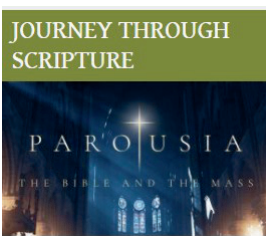
Often we begin Lent with the best of intentions, but find ourselves disappointed in our efforts when Easter arrives. These suggestions may help you stay on task.

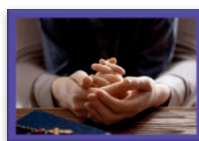

Margaret and her illegitimate child were given a home by the Franciscans in Cortona. She became a Franciscan tertiary and practiced severe self-denial. Until her son grew up, she earned their living and performed works of charity. In one vision, Christ told her she was “the third light” of the order, after Francis and Clare. Her prayers and counsel prompted many conversions and she was considered a living saint.

Some conditions that qualify include BMI  $\geq 35$ , chronic kidney disease, diabetes, immunosuppressive disease,  $\geq 65$ ,  $\geq 55$  and have cardiovascular disease, hypertension or COPD. Treatment is also available for those age 12-17 with high risk conditions.
