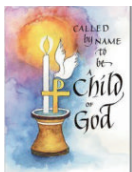

A JOURNEY IN FAITH

On Saturday, February 20th Father George conducted the Rite of Election for RCIA members. Supported by their sponsors each was “chosen by the church” to complete the last steps in their journey to full membership in the church. The rite, originally scheduled for Christ the King had to be quickly rescheduled due to a water leak at the Cathedral.

Next week the Catechumen will go through the First Scrutiny. The purpose of the Scrutinies is “to uncover, then heal all that is weak, defective, or sinful in the hearts of the elect” and “to bring out, then strengthen all that is upright and good.” They are about the overwhelming grace of God in Christ.

Please keep these adults in your prayers. The two hour class meets Monday nights. They have continued to stay focused on their desire to complete this journey in spite of cancellations and COVID restrictions. They will be received into the church at the Easter Vigil.

## Following Through With Our Lenten Intentions



Often we begin Lent with the best of intentions, but find ourselves disappointed in our efforts when Easter arrives. These suggestions may help you stay on task.

- ◆ Prayer, fasting and almsgiving are the pillars of Lent. Try to do one thing in each of these categories.
- ◆ Keep your eyes on Jesus and strive to draw closer to him. Formed.org has many resources to help you strengthen your prayer life as well as learn more about the passion and resurrection of Jesus.
- ◆ Pray the stations of the cross on Friday. Join Holy Spirit on Facebook (and hopefully Youtube) on Fridays at 6:00 PM. We will also post the stream to our webpage following the livestream. Usually within 20 minutes of the end of the livestream. Formed.org also has videos and recordings of the stations.
- ◆ Prepare your home with Lenten reminders such as a crucifix in your living area. You may want to put a purple dot or small purple cloth on it as a reminder of Lent. Find a special picture or holy card that speaks to you and display it.

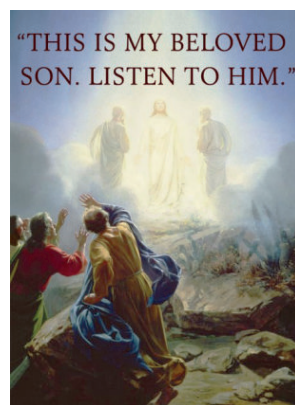

The Gospel story of the transfiguration of Jesus holds many lessons; the most prominent being the transformation of Jesus from simply being perceived as a wise and gifted prophet to the one who has fulfilled the sacred traditions of the Mosaic law and the hope of the prophets, the Messiah, the Christ. The Lord calls his stewards to participate in His redemptive activity. Heeding this call requires transformation, being willing to renounce patterns of

behavior that draw us away from God. In this coming week of Lent, let us pray for the grace to be transformed, so that by our goodness and generosity, we may walk more authentically in the footsteps of Jesus.

If you have tested positive for COVID and meet high risk criteria you may be eligible to receive Monoclonal Antibody infusion free of charge.

You will need to bring proof of positive test results and will be screened by a physician. Some conditions that qualify include BMI  $\geq$  35, chronic kidney disease, diabetes, immunosuppressive disease,  $\geq$  65,  $\geq$  55 and have cardiovascular disease, hypertension or COPD. Treatment is also available for those age 12-17 with high risk conditions.
